- Develop and maintain IEPs
- Select, adapt and use a variety of appropriate formal and informal assessment tools and strategies to evaluate the present level of functioning and ongoing needs of students
- Make recommendations to staff regarding remediation or prevention techniques and organize short-term and long-range instruction according to student needs
- Coordinate services with CAIU staff Develop relationships with parents which encourages their participation in the learning experiences of the child
- Function as a team member with instructional staff
