No. 331 – FIELD TRIPS

PURPOSE:

The board of Trustees recognizes the value of educational class trips in enhancing and enriching the school experience for the children of Infinity Charter School.

DEFINITION:

A class trip off school property for the purpose of educational enrichment and is treated as an extension of the classroom.

GUIDELINES:

As participants in school field trips, students shall be held responsible for compliance with rules set forth in advance for their conduct and infractions of those rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures as are applied during the regular school program.

Participation in school field trips is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the rules of the school. Only students who have demonstrated appropriate behavior in school and at school functions, are eligible to participate. ICS reserves the right to deny access to field trips to any student who appears physically ill, fails to complete assignments, and/or fails to follow school rules.

Extended hours field trips will be permitted when, in the judgment of the Director/CEO, the educational enhancement warrants.
