202. HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Providing Services:

The school may provide, pursuant to rules of the State Board of Education, individual instruction to students confined to home or hospital for physical disability, illness or injury, or when such confinement is recommended for psychological or psychiatric reasons.

Availability:

Homebound instruction may be available for enrolled students who are physically or psychologically handicapped and who, because of such physical or psychological incapacity, are expected to be unable to attend regular school sessions for more than 20 consecutive school days.

Review & Approval:

Applications for homebound instruction shall be made to the CEO/Director. The request shall be supported by a physician's statement, certifying that the child is unable to attend school and that he/she would profit from homebound instruction. The application will be investigated by school officials and upon approval, will be forwarded to the appropriate personnel to make the necessary arrangements.
