801. Opening Exercises/Flag Displays

PURPOSE:

The Board adopts this policy to ensure that Infinity Charter School complies with state and federal laws concerning flag displays and opening exercises while respecting the rights of individuals.

AUTHORITY:

A United States flag shall be displayed on or near each school building during school hours, in clement weather and at other times determined by the Board.

A United States flag shall be displayed in every school building.

Infinity Charter School may offer opening exercises that include a salute to the flag and/or recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance or the National Anthem.

Students may decline to recite the Pledge of Allegiance and may refrain from saluting the Flag on the basis of personal belief or religious convictions. Students who choose to refrain from such participation shall respect the rights and interests of classmates who do wish to participate.

Opening exercises may include a moment of silence.
